Paediatric HealthPathways

Victorian PHN Alliance is working with the Victorian Paediatric Clinical Network (VPCN) and the Better Access subcommittee, to translate existing state-wide Clinical Practice Guidelines (CPGs) into Paediatric HealthPathways appropriate for GP practice, which address low complexity, high volume paediatric conditions.

Optimal Care Pathways (OCP)

HealthPathways are being revised or developed to complement the Optimal Care Pathways and facilitate better coordination and quality of care. Pathways for Lung and Colorectal Cancer have been completed and work continues on the prostate and gastro-oesophageal cancer pathways
