

## FREE GoShare licences to better connect you to your patients

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Would you like to easily be able to share information with your patients at the click of a button? North Western Melbourne Primary Health Network has 50 free GoShare Healthcare licences for six-month access to interested general practices in our region.

### Background

Providing evidence-based information to your patients can improve self-management and empower people to play a more active role in their healthcare. GoShare is a platform to help general practices share health resources tailored to the patient's needs. This platform is easy to use and customisable. It allows practices to send information to one or multiple patients by SMS or email.

### How could your practice use this platform to help patients?

GoShare includes COVID-19, flu vaccination and chronic disease content bundles in a practical and engaging format.

- **COVID 19 Information Packages** - use SMS\* or email to actively "push" important information out to high risk patients. Such as prevention of or recognising symptoms of COVID – available in 10 languages. *\*Practices will need to purchase SMS packs from GoShare separately if they wish to use this feature.*
- **Chronic Disease Education** - schedule practical information to be distributed over time intervals to patients managing their chronic disease or comorbidities. This includes a range of topics such as: diabetes, osteoarthritis, heart disease, COPD, arthritis, cancer, and pain management.
- **Encourage Patient Participation** – in cancer screening programs or health assessment uptakes.
- **Tailored Delivery** – provide information in an engaging format that is suitable for that patient, via a factsheet, an animated video or patient experience videos.

### What is involved?

- Successful practices will be provided with a six-month free trial of the GoShare Licence, with possible extension to 12 months.
- Practices will receive onboarding support, education and help desk access from GoShare to allow streamlined use of the software.

- Access to all content on the GoShare HealthCare website, including COVID-19, Immunisations and Chronic Disease content bundles, information sheets, animated video series and ‘speaking from experience’ digital library.
- Detailed reporting of internal use including opening rates to track success of program.
