## Advice for aged care providers

- From 17 September 2021, it will be mandatory for all residential aged care workers to be vaccinated COVID-19.
- The Australian Government is supporting aged care providers and their workers requiring the vaccine by [funding additional leave if required](#).
- All aged care workers are being prioritised to receive their vaccines using the options above.
- All aged care workers, regardless of age, can access the Pfizer vaccine.
- Any staff or residents awaiting a second dose can use the options above.
