COVID-19 vaccination options for aged care workers and residents

The following COVID-19 vaccination options are available for residential aged care workers and residents in the North Western Melbourne Primary Health Network region.

Aspen Medical have been contracted by the Commonwealth to conduct one in-reach clinic per facility for booster doses, but facilities can choose to organise other providers if they wish.

Advice for aged care providers

- From 17 September 2021, it became mandatory for all residential aged care workers to be vaccinated COVID-19.
- The Australian Government is supporting aged care providers and their workers requiring the vaccine by <u>funding additional leave if required</u>.
- All aged care workers are being prioritised to receive their vaccines using the options above.
- Any staff or residents awaiting a first, second or booster dose can use the options above.
- To receive a booster dose, all residents and workers must have provided consent, and have their first and second vaccination statuses visible on AIR. Visit the <u>Australian Department of</u> <u>Health website</u> for the latest information on the booster dose interval.
