

## Q & A

### What is it & what does it do?

The General Practice Respiratory Clinic is a Department of Health funded service supported by the Victorian Primary Health Networks and delivered by DPV Health for the Northern Melbourne region.

The clinics will; Undertake respiratory assessments of symptomatic clients, including COVID-19 testing of symptomatic patients, support management of patient's immediate respiratory illness, refer patients back to their usual GP for ongoing care or assist to identify a GP if they do not already have one, and direct people, who test positive to COVID-19, to receive care through the COVID Positive Pathways program, which links people to clinical care, monitoring and support services.

### Who should attend?

Those with mild to moderate suspected symptoms of COVID-19 can attend a General Practice Respiratory Clinic. Symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath, a sore throat, runny nose and/ or tiredness. As well as anyone with the following conditions, Asthma, COPD (chronic inflammatory lung disease), Pneumonia and Influenza.
