



Are you going to get your first, second or 'booster' COVID-19 vaccine?

We are looking for a wide selection of Victorians to contribute samples to the Victorian COVID-19 Vaccinees Collection (or VC²).

We will ask you some basic questions about you and your health. You will then be asked to provide samples before and up to six timepoints after you receive your COVID-19 vaccines.

Collected samples (blood and saliva) will be made available to Victorian researchers who want to answer important questions about the safety and effectiveness of COVID-19 vaccines.

We are looking for diverse members of the general population, and subgroups who may experience an altered vaccine response, including but not limited to:

- Healthcare workers
- People who have had SARS-CoV-2 infection
- People over the age of 70
- People living with HIV
- People with an underlying immunosuppressive condition or on immunosuppressive medications, including people with rheumatological disease or who have received solid organ transplants
- People with chronic kidney disease
- Pregnant women
