

## General practitioners' views and experiences about access to reablement or rehabilitation services for people with dementia

*Give us your perspective about access to reablement or rehabilitation services for people with dementia to optimise their independence and well-being*

We are seeking general practitioners to take part in a once-off interview aimed at improving access to reablement or rehabilitation for people with dementia.



### *Am I eligible to participate in the interview?*

You are eligible if you:

- Are a current practising general practitioner in Victoria
- Provide consultation to people with dementia

### *Why should I take part in this interview?*

- Your experience and opinions will help us understand a general practitioner's role in referring people with dementia to reablement or rehabilitation services;
- Identify the barriers/enablers in accessing these services for people with dementia to inform future strategies to improve access to these services;
- It may help you reflect on your practice for people with dementia.

### *What will it involve?*

- Attend an once-off individual interview (approximately 30 minutes) conducted by the researcher via on-line (Zoom or telephone) or face-to-face (at the general practitioner's room) at a mutually convenient time
- The interview will be audio-recorded
- An email may be sent to you for your feedback regarding the results to ensure accuracy of our interpretation of your experience

### *Is there a payment for the interview?*

- You will receive a \$150 e-gift card for your time in the interview

### *Who can I contact to participate in the interview?*

A researcher will explain the study to you and check that you are eligible to participate. An Explanatory Statement (which explains the study) and a Consent Form will be sent to you prior to the interview. Consenting process will be completed with you before the interview.
