

### What will happen to my information?

To determine if our programs have achieved the desired objectives, it is necessary to capture some of your personal information. That includes names, email addresses and your RACGP number (if applicable). However, any data that you provide will be encrypted and stored securely by the research team in a database located within the University of Adelaide. Only the research team will have access to that information. All data will be maintained by the University of Adelaide for 5 years from the publication date, as per Section 2 of the [Australian Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research, 2018](#).

The results of this program will be prepared in a report for North Western Melbourne Primary Health Network. It may also be written up for publication in an academic journal, and may be presented at conferences. However, all information will be completely de-identified so there is no confidentiality risk to you.
