#### PAEDIATRIC ENDOCRINOLOGIST UPDATE

Dr Gabby Atlas, Paediatric Endocrinologist shares some 'top tips' below:

- Suspicious about a new diagnosis of diabetes in a child? Perform point of care glucose testing (fingerprick or urine). If not available, sent directly to the ED. It is not advised to arrange formal bloods, which delays the diagnosis and puts the child at risk of life-threatening diabetic ketoacidosis.
- When referring a child with concerns about growth or puberty, arrange a bone age xray in preparation for the consultation.
- New/evolving hypothyroidism we would typically treat with thyroxine if the TSH rises above 10.
- Typical timing for onset of puberty is age 8-13 in girls and 9-14 in boys. Signs of breast development in females or genital changes in males prior to this warrants an urgent review.
