- Demonstrated experience and understanding of trauma informed care
- Ability to perform comprehensive patient assessments, plan, implement, and evaluate clinical care and primary health care strategies, including appropriate investigations, treatment and referrals
- Ability to contribute and motivate an effective team of clinicians and health professionals and others to achieve identified outcomes
- Experience in contributing to "best practice" approaches in clinical practice, clinical polices, systems and procedures
- Demonstrated competence in patient information management systems and other relevant IT
- Good written and verbal communication skills and the ability to communicate effectively with patients, carers and the Aboriginal community
