


# PIP QI Data Submission Options

This table outlines the two options for general practices to submit the Practice Incentives Program Quality Improvement (PIP QI) eligible data set to North Western Melbourne Primary Health Network (NWMPHN).

<b>Option 2: Submit aggregated PIP eligible data set (JSON file) manually via POLAR portal</b>	✓ Manual submission: practice extracts a JSON file (aggregated PIP eligible data set - 10 measures only) from their clinical system and submits this file to NWMPHN via the POLAR portal.	License includes:  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Access to POLAR Portal for JSON file submission</li> </ul>	Practice is responsible for extracting JSON files from their clinical system (in the correct format) and submitting these files quarterly via the POLAR portal.  PHN will ensure that data is received quarterly.  Any issues with data submission will be followed up by NWMPHN/Outcome Health.	Practice is required to:  1) Sign a Data Sharing Agreement  2) Extract a JSON file in the required format and submit JSON file to POLAR portal on a quarterly basis.	Nil cost to practice.
