# Identify patients at risk of unplanned hospitalisation eligible for a GPCCMP or GPCCMP review

This walkthrough will allow you to identify patients who are at-risk for an unplanned hospital admission who are eligible for a GPCCMP.

### **Step One**

Open POLAR. Under the "Report" menu, select your Hospital Avoidance Tool report.



#### **Step Two**

Ensure the RACGP Active filter has been applied in the top left corner of your screen.



#### **Step Three**

Select the cohort of patients you wish to action – Urgent, High or Medium Risk – by clicking the filter on the left side of your screen.



## **Step Four**

Select the "Available MBS services" tab above the list of names.

You can now identify which patients have never had a care plan item, or who may be eligible to transition to the new GPCCMP when they present for a review.
