Step 1

Open POLAR under Reports select PIP QI Report

Step 2

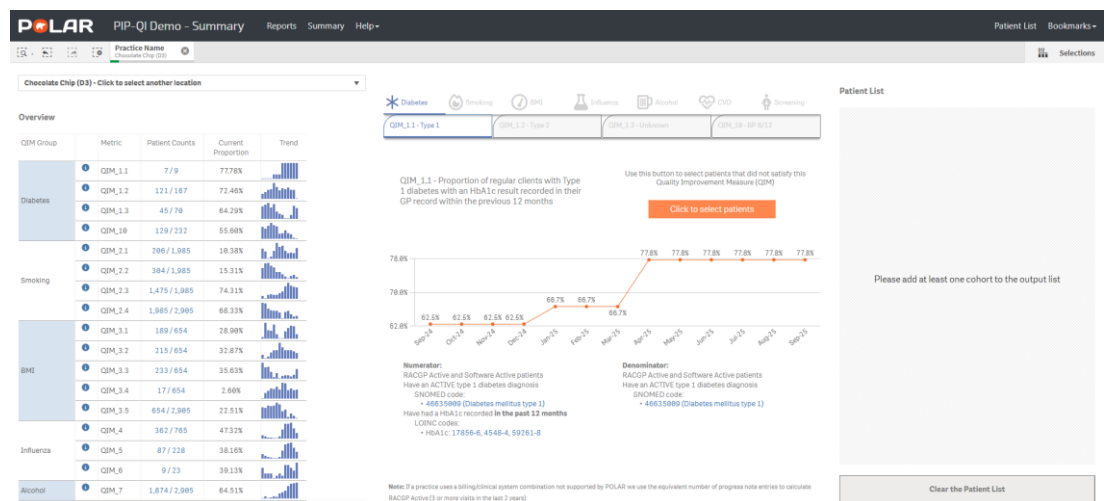
The report will open in 3 sections:

1) the Overview with the Quality Improvement measures (QIMs) listed with the patient counts, % and a trend line.

2) the middle section provides a detailed breakdown for each QIM and,

3) the Patient List (right section) displays patient cohorts that are not meeting the criterion (when selected).

Note: For Smoking and BMI tabs, the last measure is the PIP QI data quality measure and the measures in front instead show prevalence of BMI and smoking status amongst the patient cohort.



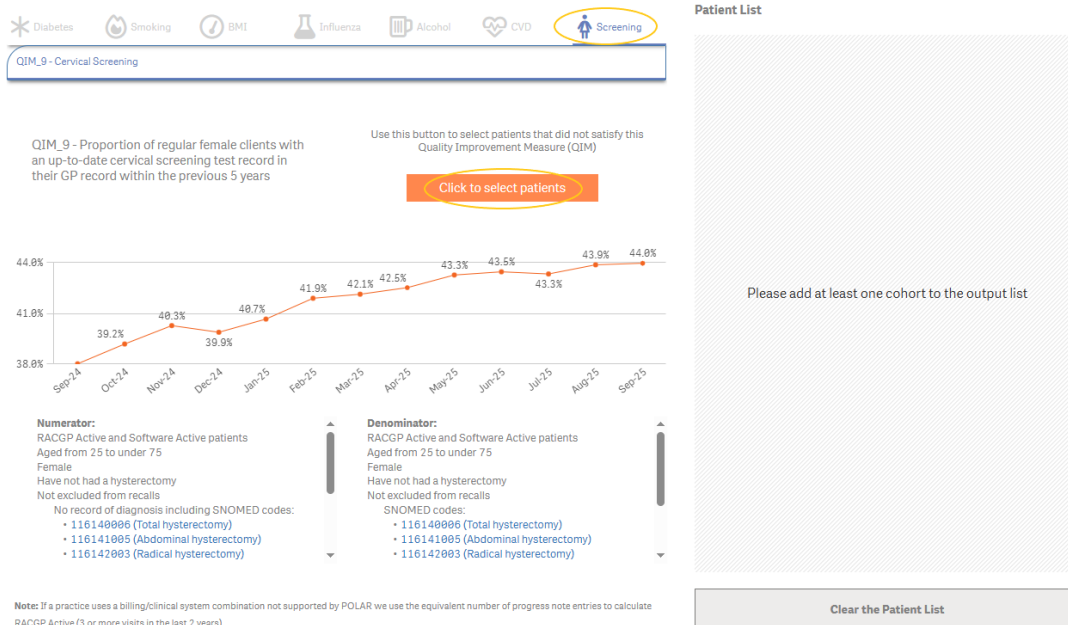
QIM_2.4 - Proportion of regular clients with a smoking status record in their GP record

Step 3

Select the QIM tab you wish to work on then, click on the orange button named 'Click to select Patients' to bring up the patient list.



Step 3 Click 'Patient List' to export to excel

As an example, we will select the topic Cervical Screening (QIM 9).

To get the list of patients who have not had their cervical screening completed, select the orange 'Click to Select Patients' box, then select 'Patient List' and 'Export to Excel' to export to excel.
