This infographic details the key steps to participate in BBPIP, including registering the practice in the Organisation Register, registering to MyMedicare and BBPIP, and accessing eligibility assessments and payment details.



Setup the Organisation Register


Firstly, you need an individual Provider Digital Access (PRODA) account to be able to access an Organisation PRODA account:

- · Register for an individual PRODA account
- Register your organisation or join an existing organisation.



You need your Organisation PRODA account to be linked to Health Professional Online Services (HPOS). Once linked, you will need to set up your organisation and practice site/s in the Organisation Register:

When creating an Organisation Site record make sure to add **all** providers of the practice.

Register for MyMedicare and BBPIP

In the Organisation site record, under the Program Registration tab:

- Select MyMedicare from the New Program dropdown and select Add Program.
- Complete the MyMedicare Registration Details.
- · Complete the Declaration and select Save.
- Select MyMedicare BBPIP from the New Program dropdown and select Add Program.

Note: Banking details saved for MyMedicare also apply to BBPIP.



Accessing MyMedicare in HPOS allows practices and providers to view Eligibility assessments and Payment details for BBPIP.

Take note!

Pre-November 2025, practices can complete steps 1-2 & register for MyMedicare.

From November, add BBPIP as a program.

Eligibility assessments allow practices and providers to monitor and confirm **eligibility for BBPIP payment**.

Eligibility Assessments

There are **2 types** of assessments:

- Forecast assessments can be used for monitoring BBPIP eligibility during the quarter.
- Final assessments are used for final payment determination at the end of the quarter.




Access eligibility assessments

To access eligibility assessments, practices and providers should:

- Log in to PRODA and access HPOS
- On the HPOS home page, select:

My programs > MyMedicare > View Payment Eligibility

Create a forecast assessment

On the Incentive assessments screen, select the **Forecast assessment** tab > Select the **BBPIP Incentive** > Select the **Organisation site** or **Medicare provider number (MPN)** > Select **Forecast**.

Once completed, the forecast assessment will be available within the Search assessments tab.

Search for eligibility assessments


On the Incentive assessments screen, select the **Search assessments** tab > Select the **BBPIP Incentive** > Select **Organisation site** or **MPN** > Select **Financial quarter** (if desired) > Select **Search**.




View eligibility assessments

In the search results for a:

- forecast assessment, select View forecast
- final assessment, select View assessment.





Payment details allow practices and providers to view quarterly payment information shortly after the end of the quarter.

To access payment details, practices and providers should:


- Log in to PRODA and access HPOS

Search for payment details


On the Search payment history screen, select the **BBPIP Incentive** > Select the **Organisation site**, **MPN** or **Payment ID** (unique ID on your bank statement) > Select **Search**.





To view payment details in the search results select **View details** on the relevant row.

Payment details will highlight an amount paid, an amount to be offset, or a failed payment.
