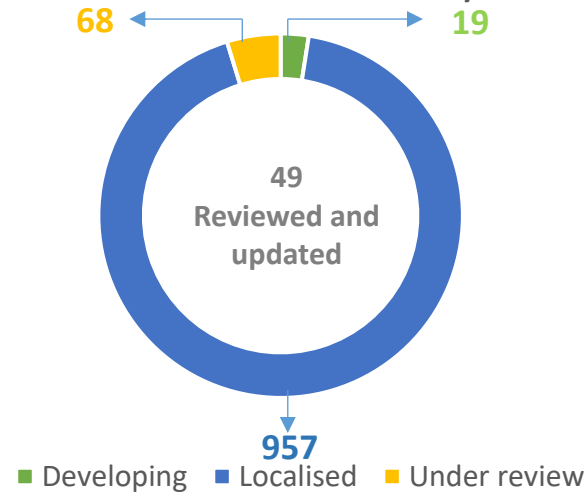

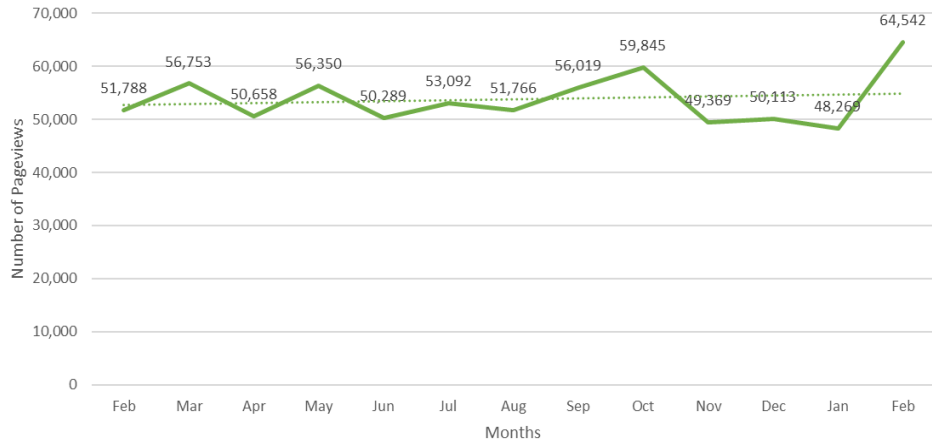

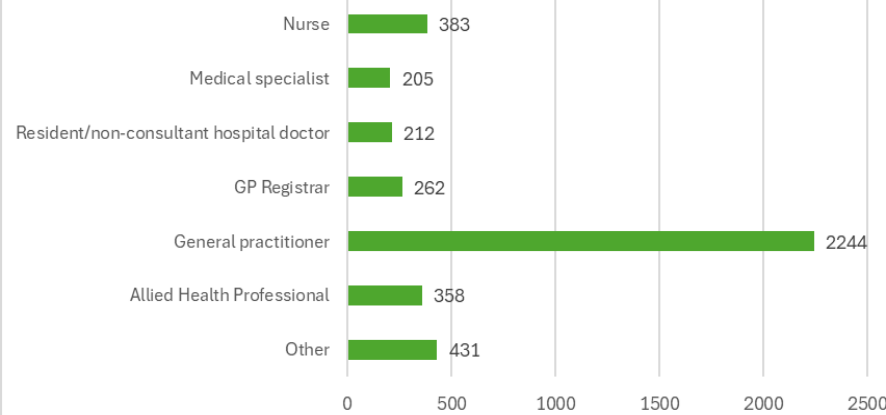

Top Searches & Most Viewed Pathways



- February activity increased significantly, with 64,542 total views (up from 48,269).
- Top viewed pathways closely matched search behavior, with large increases in Hypertension (206 → 333 views), Abnormal LFTs (206 → 333) and Headaches in Adults (150 → 327). Antenatal Care – First Consult remained the most viewed pathway overall (350 → 410). This shows strong alignment between what GPs searched for and the pathways they accessed
- Searches increased across key conditions, especially Hypertension, Gout, PCOS and UTI, which all saw notable rises in February compared with January.

GP Engagement



- Total users increased from 3,909 in January to 4,101 in February, showing stronger overall engagement across the platform
- We ran a GP Registrar promotion campaign with RACGP, providing HPM slides for their Registrar Orientation session. This contributed to a strong rise in GP Registrar uptake, increasing from 155 in January to 262 in February, supporting the overall lift in new user numbers.
- General Practitioners remained the highest users in February with over 19,000 page views, and the strong uplift in new GP Registrars reflects how the RACGP orientation session helped boost awareness and early adoption of HealthPathways Melbourne.

Practice Nurses and Managers

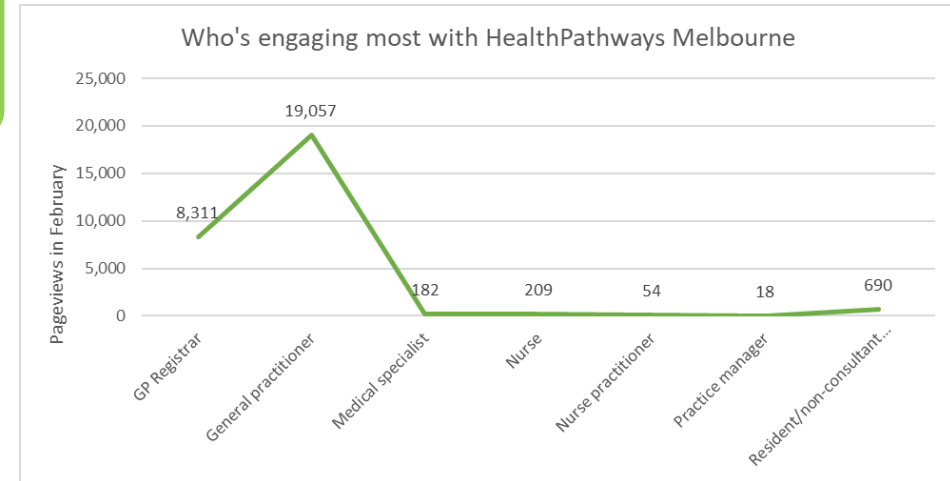


- Practice Managers: Increased activity on Hyperlipidaemia pathway.
- Practice Nurses: Higher engagement with Women’s health, acute services and NDIS schemes

Key Clinical Focus Areas



- Hypertension, Gout and PCOS remained among the most sought-after topics, with substantial increases in both searches and pathway views in February, suggesting consistent interest in chronic disease areas.
- Women’s health stayed prominent: Antenatal Care – First Consult led all pathways for a second month, while Pregnancy and PCOS searches rose noticeably
- Respiratory conditions such as COPD and Headaches in Adults saw marked growth, consistent with increased clinical presentations typical in early-year months. Acute Exacerbation of COPD entered the February top-viewed list with 342 views.



February shows a clear uplift in platform engagement across several measures.

Total page views rose to 64,542, up significantly from 48,269 in January (+34%). The platform also recorded 4,101 total users, an increase from 3,909 the previous month, with 187 new users joining in February.

These results suggest more than seasonal variation, pointing instead to renewed momentum and growing relevance of the clinical referral pathways platform. The concurrent growth in both total and new users indicates the program is successfully attracting new users while continuing to engage existing ones.
