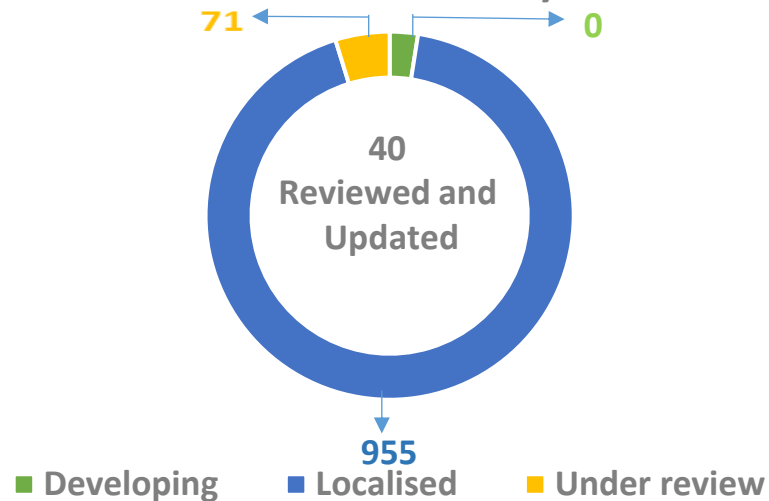

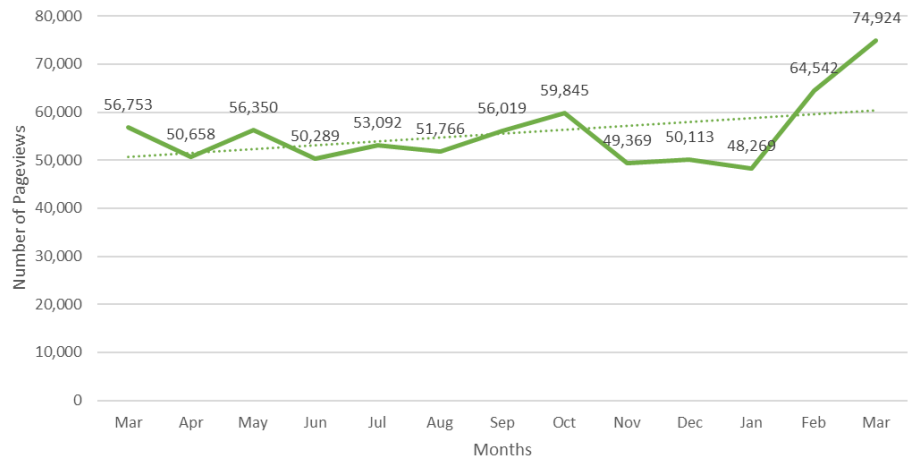

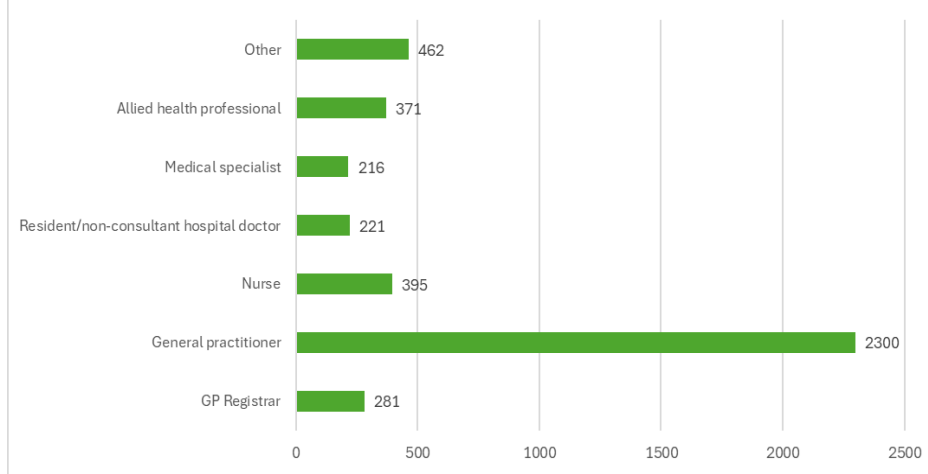

# Pathways and Engagement Statistics

## Top Searches & Most Viewed Pathways



- March recorded 74,924 total views; an increase of 10,382 views compared with 64,542 views in February, indicating higher overall activity on the platform during March.
- Hypertension continued as the most searched topic, increasing from 181 searches in February to 203 in March. Other notable increases were seen for UTI (141 → 165 searches), ADHD (120 → 151) and osteoporosis (112 → 137).
- Among top GP pathway views, Antenatal Care – First Consult remained the most viewed page overall with 295 views, followed by Hypertension (274) and Abnormal Liver Function Tests (254). Compared with February, view counts for individual top pathways were lower; however, the higher total pageviews suggest use was distributed across a wider range of pathways rather than concentrated on a small number of topics.

## GP Engagement



- The total number of registered users increased from 4,128 in February to 4,246 in March (+118 users). Despite fewer new registrations in March (118 users), total platform views increased by over 16%, suggesting increased use of the platform by existing users.
- General Practitioners continued to form the largest proportion of users, accounting for 2,300 registered users (53.7%), with nurses (395 users) and allied health professionals (371 users) together representing approximately 18% of the user base, indicating continued engagement across the wider practice team.

## Practice Nurses and Managers

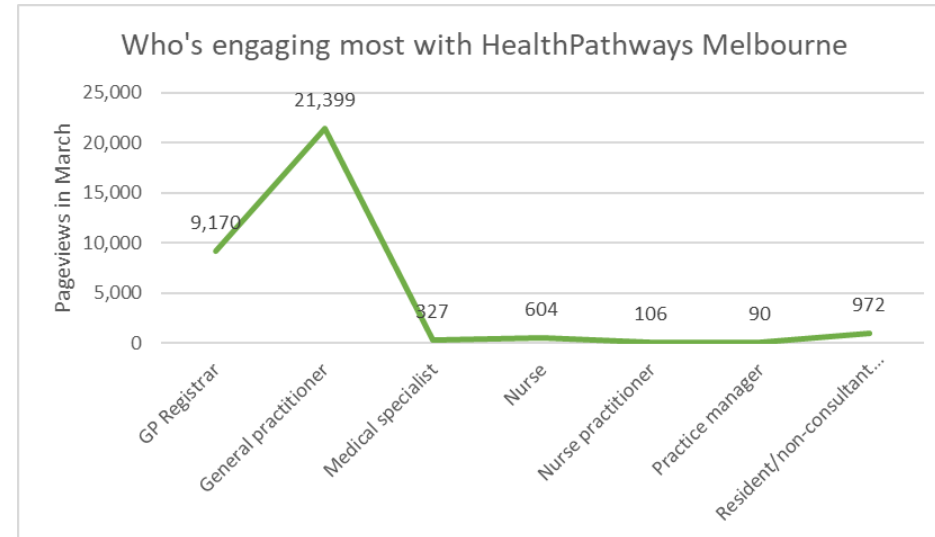


- Practice Managers: Increased activity on Hyperlipidaemia and National Health Services Directory pathway.
- Practice Nurses: Higher engagement with Acute services and Child health related pathways.
- Overall nurse engagement grew significantly in March, rising to 600 views compared with 209 in February.

## Key Clinical Focus Areas



- Hypertension, osteoporosis and gout remained key areas of clinical focus in March, featuring prominently in both top search terms (203, 137 and 162 searches respectively) and top GP-viewed pathways (Hypertension: 274 views; Osteoporosis: 189; Gout and Pseudogout: 163), reflecting continued demand for chronic disease management guidance.
- Women's health continued to be a major area of engagement, with Antenatal Care – First Consult remaining the most viewed GP pathway overall (295 views), alongside sustained search interest in PCOS (134 searches) and menopause (118 searches).
- Investigation and assessment-focused pathways featured strongly among GP views in March, including Abnormal Liver Function Tests (254 views), Chronic Kidney Disease (176), Haematuria in Adults (170) and Hyperthyroidism (159), highlighting ongoing use of HealthPathways to support diagnostic decision-making in general practice.
